

# Ticknall Trail Relay: Entry Form

**Event:** The inaugural inter-club relay for UK Athletics/TRA affiliated club members. The event is entirely on off-road, with 4 legs of approximately 2 miles.

**Date:** 4<sup>th</sup> July 2017    **Sign on** from 6.15pm.    **Start Time** 7pm    **Entry.** £16 per team.

**Headquarters:** Ticknall Village Hall, with the start about 5 mins walk away.

**Pre-Registration:** Pre-register your team via the Peak Running website at [www.peakrunning.co.uk](http://www.peakrunning.co.uk). Entry on the day for teams not pre-register only if places are available. The overall number of teams will be limited, so register early. (Minimum age limit for competitors is 12 years).

**Parking:** Please car share. Parking will be available at the Village Hall. If using the car park you are encouraged to make a small donation in the wall slot (e.g. £1), which helps to maintain the car park and keep it open. Please park sensibly and DO NOT park on Chapel Street. There are toilets at the Village Hall, please do not use the fields and hedges.

**Sign on:** Finalised team members will need to sign this form and accept the disclaimer, before one member brings the form and payment to the registration desk.

In the event of a team not having a full complement, you may still take part with a minimum of 2 runners. However, individuals may not run consecutive legs or represent more than one team, and under 17's may only run 1 leg.

**Start:** The start and finish is at the Market Place Ticknall, on the end of Chapel Lane, opposite to the Calke Park entrance.

**Route:** The route will be all off-road on bridleways and permissive paths and woodland. The route will be marked and there will be direction signs and/or marshals at key points.

**Prizes and Prize Giving:** Prizes will be awarded to the first team in the Men's, Women's and Mixed (min 2 ladies) Categories. There will also be a best performing club prize, decided on a point's basis.

Prizes will be awarded at the Village Hall as soon as possible after all teams have finished.

Please respect the area, do not drop litter and remember this is a residential area.

Finally, enjoy yourself!

Afterwards. There are 2 pubs in Ticknall, the Wheel and Staff of Life.
